THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST – JUNE 03, 2018

GOSPEL REFLECTION - MK 14,12-16.22-26

Every time we celebrate the Mass, we remember how the sorrowful Lord shared his own life for us and left us an everlasting memorial, so we may remember how he loved us until his death on the Cross. Times had changed, and the way we celebrate the Sacred. The appreciation of the présence is still there, as we fill our churches every Sunday, listening to readings and receiving the body of Jesus. We are a part of the big assembly of God's people who continuously offer with Jesus, our lives with his, our prayers and aspirations with his, believing that this sacrifice is pleasing to God the Almighty Father. Are we spiritually composed before receiving him in Holy Communion, by going first to the Sacrament of Penance? Do we believe that what we receive is Jesus in all his love, sacrifice and life? Outside the Mass, do we live as one holy sacrifice, living and loving in memory of Jesus? This Sunday, which we dedicate to the Body and Blood of Jesus, let us remember that our life as Christians is centered on the Blessed Eucharist, and that we do this in memory of Him!

SOLEMNITY CORPUS CHRISTI: THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

The Feast of Corpus Christi goes back to the 13th century, but it celebrates something far older: the institution of the Sacrament of Holy Communion at the Last Supper. This celebration is commonly used as an opportunity for public Eucharistic processions, which serves as a sign of common faith and adoration. Our worship of Jesus in His Body and Blood calls us to offer to God a pledge of undivided love and an offering of ourselves to the service of others. Many conversions are a result of Eucharistic Adoration experienced from inside the Church. Just think for a moment, how many more there would be if we could reach out and invite those who do not have time for God and the Sunday Eucharist?

CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY

Sunday, June 3, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. On this day, **Eucharistic procession outside of the Church will start after 10:30 a.m. Mass**. It is our witness and testimony to our faith. Please come and walk with us in this procession and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

JUNE 8 - SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS

On the Feast of the Sacred Heart, we can gain a plenary indulgence by making an Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart. Jesus promised that: He will give them all the graces in their state of life, establish peace in their homes, comfort them in all their afflictions. Sinners will find in His Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy. He will bless every place in which an image of His Heart is exposed and honored. He will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts. Who shall promote this devotion will have their names written in His Heart. His love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays in nine consecutive months, the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in His disgrace, nor without receiving their sacraments. His divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.

JUNE 8 - WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR PRIESTS

Catholics worldwide are urged to pray for priest on the World day of Prayer for Priests. The day was begun by St. John Paul II in 2002 with the objective of having all Catholic faithful join in prayer for the sanctification of priests.

JUNE 9 - THE IMMACULATE HEART OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY.

The Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary follows the day of the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Both devotions are closely linked with each other because "Mary's role in the Church is inseparable from her union with Christ and flows directly from it....This union of the mother with the Son in the work of salvation is made manifest from the time of Christ's virginal conception up to his death," (CCC nos. 964, 1172).

MISSION APPEALS—JUNE 30 & JULY 1, 2018

Fr. Fredrick M. Koro will be representing the diocese of Nakuru in the 2018 mission coop. He will speak at our parish on **Saturday, June 30 and Sunday, July 1, 2018 at all Masses**. "The Catholic Diocese of Nakuru (CDN), Kenya, was established in 1968. Presently, the diocese is involved in pastoral care and promoting human development activities in Nakuru and Baringo. Our plan is to: Provide targeted supplementary feeding to 5,000 school-going children. Provide access to safe water for an estimated 50,000 individuals in pastoral and marginal agricultural areas affected by drought. Promote hygiene and sanitation for an estimated 50,000 individuals in pastoral and marginal agricultural areas affected by drought".

REFLEKSJA EWANGELICZNA - MK 14,12-16,22-26

Dzisiejsza Ewangelia przypomina nam że Bóg jest z nami, byśmy mogli, poprzez Jego słowo i Jego obecność, przybliżać się do poznania Prawdy. Abyśmy stawali się apostołami. Jednak Jego nauka to jedno, a nasze życie tą nauką - to drugie. Ze względu na nasze słabości, nie potrafimy wiernie iść za Jezusem. Znieskałcamy swoim życiem Jego naukę. Nasze serca są jeszcze zamknięte na istotę Małej Drogi Miłości. Stąd tyle niepokojów, nieporozumień, zawirowań i nieposłuszeństwa. Żeby dobrze zrozumieć, przyjąć prawdziwie sercem i żyć tą nauką, musi minąć trochę czasu. Musi ta nauka przełożyć się na życie w nas. Zachwycać się można zawsze jakąś duchowością, ale nie oznacza to jednak, że się na nią prawdziwie weszło. Wielu z nas chętnie słucha. Przytakujemy głowami. Jednak nie żyjemy tym prawdziwie, bowiem swoim sercem przyjmujemy tylko to, co nam odpowiada. Niby kroczymy już Drogą Miłości, a jednak nie realizujemy wszystkich jej założen.

Gdy będziemy tę modlitwę praktykować, także w naszych sercach wzrośnie miłość ku Bogu i bliźnim.
