**GOSPEL REFLECTION LK 3,1-6**  
**Why do we gather here each Sunday to celebrate the sacred meal of the Lord? Because as we say later: when we eat this bread and drink this cup we proclaim the Lord's death until he comes. Now in Advent we recall the past when Jesus first gathered disciples, but we also remember the future when he will come again in glory. Then we will be delivered from all that binds us, but before then we must take John the Baptist as our model: 'we must prepare a way for the Lord' within the world we live in. During the season of Advent, we choose to add many activities to our family's schedule to prepare for our celebration of Christmas. John the Baptist reminds us that our repentance is another way in which we can prepare for the Lord's coming and our celebration of Christmas. Our Parish offer a communal celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation during the Advent season (Monday, December 17 in the morning from ..... to and afternoon from ..... to .....). You and Your family might choose to participate in this sacrament. We are looking forward to Christmas: the Christ we seek to welcome calls us to look forward in the way we live – this is repentance and preparing the way; and he calls us to look forward to his own coming in glory.**

**HOW TO MAKE A GOOD CONFESSION**

(Lesson 32 from the Baltimore Catechism)

**How to prepare ourselves for a good confession?** We take sufficient time to examine our conscience and to excite in our hearts sincere sorrow for our sins and a firm purpose not to commit them again.

**How should we confess?** Entering the confessional, we kneel, and making the sign of the cross we say to the priest: "Bless me, Father, for I have sinned"; and then we tell how long it has been since our last confession. Then, if we have committed any mortal sins since last confession, we must confess them, and also any that we have forgotten in previous confessions, telling the nature and number of each; we may also confess any venial sins we wish to mention.

**What should we do if we cannot remember the exact number of our mortal sins?** We should tell the number as nearly as possible, or say how often we have committed the sins in a day, a week, a month, or a year.

**What should we do when we have committed no mortal sin since our last confession?** We should confess our venial sins or some sin told in a previous confession, for which we are again sorry, in order that the priest may give us absolution.

**How should we end our confession?** By saying: "I am sorry for these and all the sins of my past life, especially for ..."; and then it is well to tell one or several of the sins which we have previously confessed and for which we are particularly sorry.

**What should we do after confessing our sins?** We should answer truthfully any question the priest asks, seek advice if we feel that we need any, listen carefully to the spiritual instruction and counsel of the priest, and accept the penance he gives us.

**What should we do when the priest is giving us absolution?** We should say from our heart the act of contrition in a tone to be heard by him.

**What should we do after leaving the confessional?** We should return thanks to God for the sacrament we have received, beg Our Lord to supply for the imperfections of our confession and devoutly perform our penance.

**THE DIFFERENCES IN SINS**

There are two kinds of actual sin, **mortal** and **venial**. **Mortal sin is** a great offense against God. Three simultaneous conditions must be fulfilled for a mortal sin: (1) the act must be something very serious; (2) the person must have sufficient understanding of what is being done; (3) the person must have sufficient freedom of the will. So we cannot commit a mortal sin if the matter is not serious (e.g., if I stole a small amount of money from my employer), or if we did not know what we were doing (e.g., if we were to hurt someone accidentally or unthinkingly), or if we did not act with full freedom (e.g., we were under physical or emotional pressure). A Catholic should know well the difference between mortal and venial sins. Deliberately missing Sunday Mass without sufficient cause is to be considered a very serious mortal sin.
