GOSPEL REFLECTION LK 6,39-45

Jesus used an analogy from his own background as a carpenter. He pointed to the temptation in leaders to make negative, and sometimes rash, moral judgments. It was easier to point and condemn, than to take time to reflect, take stock, and reform. The analogy of the speck and the beam implied a greater issue for Christians: repentance. The critic cannot repent, unless critical focus was pointed inward.

SEASON OF LENT

The liturgical season of Lent begins this Wednesday, March 6th. Lent has been part of the Church's life for at least the past 1700 years. It began as a period of special preparation for adults being baptized during the Easter vigil. Gradually it became a period of penance and conversion for public sinners and also for devout members of the community.

**SUGGESTIONS FOR A MORE MEANINGFUL
LENTEN THIS YEAR**

***Give up sin.** Show your love for God by keeping His commandments and turn away from sin. ***Fast.** An empty stomach can lead to more attentive prayer. Give the money you saved on food to others in alms. ***Pray.** Be in constant prayer. Pray for your family and friends, for those who suffer, and for the Church and the world. ***Do good works.** Help those in need. Pray for them and be ready to serve them in their time of need. ***Give alms.** Help the poor and support the good works of the Church. Give cheerfully to God who has given us everything we have. ***Abstain.** Give up meat or other desirable foods during Lent, especially on Friday, the day of Christ's saving death on the cross. ***Do meditative reading.** Nourish your faith by spending time in quiet reading and reflection. Prayerful reading of God's word each day will open your heart to the Spirit, and ways influence yours. ***Control desire for possessions.** Build up treasures in heaven rather than on earth. Cut down on material possessions, eliminate frills, lessen wants, share yourself your time and your talents with others. ***Control desire for entertainment.** Too much entertainment and other distractions can lead to no time for the works of the Lord. ***Carry out duties in life.** Serve God by living in love each day. Offer your daily life through Christ.

WHAT IS FAST AND ABSTINENCE?

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are universal days of fast and abstinence. Catholics still consider Fridays throughout Lent as days of abstinence. Anyone between the ages of 18 and 59 is obliged to fast and abstain. Fasting, is the limitation of food and drink – typically to one main meal and two smaller meals, with no solid foods in between. Abstaining, in this context, is the refraining from certain kinds of food or drink, typically meat. Instead of fasting, one may substitute works of charity.

REFLEKSJA EWANGELICZNA ŁK 6,39-45

Jezus jest moim nauczycielem. Przemawia do mnie w swojej szkole miłości słowem prostym, które przekonująco apeluje do mojego życia, i czynem skutecznym, który daje mi poznać Jego moc. Mam w tej szkole zdobywać mądrość życia i postępować w miłości. A przez to samemu stawać się nauczycielem. To z kolei nakazuje mi zachować pokorę i czuwać. Pokora potrzebna jest po to, aby twardo stąpać po ziemi, w świadomości, że zanim jako nauczyciel wezmę się do napominania grzesznych i pouczania nieumiejętnych, powiniensem dostrzec własne słabości. ŚW. KAZIMIERZ

4 marca wypada święto Kazimierza, gorliwego czciciela Eucharystii i Matki Bożej, który bronił najuboższych, stając się ich orędownikiem wobec swojego ojca, króla Kazimierza Jagiellończyka.

ŚRODA POPIEŁCOWA

W tym tygodniu, 6 marca, przypada Środa Popielcowa. Otwiera ona święty, szczególny czas Wielkiego Postu. Msze Święte tego dnia o godz. 8:30 i 18:00 po angielsku i o godz. 19:00 po polsku. Posypanie głowy popiołem przypomina, że wszystko co ziemskie, powstało z prochu ziemi i znów w proch się obróci. Ten rozpad jest skutkiem grzechu. Jednak kapłan, posypując głowy, czyni nad nimi znak krzyża, który oznacza oczyszczenie i zmartwychwstanie. Zatem Wielki Post – czas pokuty, postu, wyrzeczeń i modlitwy – ma służyć naszemu nawróceniu i przygotowaniu do przeżycia radosnych świąt Zmartwychwstania Pańskiego.

POST IŁOŚCIOWY I JAKOŚCIOWY

Pamiętajmy, że w Popielec obowiązuje post ścisły, polegający na wstrzemiążliwości od pokarmów mięsnych i spożyciu jednego posiłku do syta w ciągu dnia. Pozostałe posiłki muszą zostać ograniczone co do ilości. Ten post obowiązuje wszystkich pomiędzy 18 a 59 rokiem życia. Pozostałych wiernych zachęcamy także do czynnego włączenia się w ten wielki akt pokutny, na miarę ich możliwości. Wszystkich od 14. roku życia obowiązuje wstrzemiążliwość od pokarmów mięsnych.
