GOSPEL REFLECTION JOHN 1,29-34

This Sunday's Gospel is the encounter between John the Baptist and Jesus. When John sees Jesus, he exclaims: "Look! There is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. It is He of whom I said: 'After me will come a man who ranks ahead of me because he was before me'." John then confesses that he had not recognized Jesus as the Lamb of God. Jesus and John had known one another from birth; they were cousins. Yet until this moment, John had not realized that Jesus was "The Christ." John then gave this testimony: "I saw the Spirit descend and rest on someone; it is He who will baptize with the Holy Spirit. I have seen for myself and I have testified, 'This is God's chosen One.'" Ask yourself: do you truly believe that Jesus is "The Lamb of God?" I suspect that many of us "grew up" with the Gospel and we were taught about Jesus and his life from our childhood. Yet today ask yourself: Do I truly believe and confess that Jesus is "The Lamb of God?" Many of us know about Jesus, however do we listen daily for His word in our life? Are Jesus and his teachings integral in your life? Or do you simply give "lip service" to your faith? Today I invite you to take time to search your heart and mind. LITURGICAL CELEBRATION THIS WEEK

January 21 – St. Agnes - Virgin, Martyr - 291 – c. 304
St. Agnes is one of seven women besides the Blessed Virgin to be mentioned in the Canon of the Mass. **She is the patron of chastity, young girls, engaged couples and virgins.**

January 24 – St. Francis de Sales – 21 August 1567 – 28 December 162Bishop of Geneva, Doctor of the Church. He was a kind and caring person who shared God's love with others. He taught people to trust in God. He said, "Have no fear for what tomorrow may bring. The same loving God who cares for you today will take care of you tomorrow and every day." Francis was beatified the year he died, 1622 and canonized in 1665. In 1923, Pope Pius XI named **St. Francis de Sales** the patron saint of Catholic writers and the Catholic press because of the tracts and books he wrote. He is also the patron saint of the deaf, journalists, adult education, and the Sisters of St. Joseph.

January 25 - Conversion of St. Paul. This day was a turning point in the history of the early Church. **He became a passionate follower and later a teacher of the nations.** The letters, or epistles, of Paul offer us a window into the early Church.

WORD OF GOD SUNDAY

In response to a request from Pope Francis, Christ The King parish, in conjunction with parishes world-wide, will have a special 10:30a.m. Mass on Sunday January 26, 2020 to celebrate the Word of God Sunday. This is a global event. You will not want to miss it. In order to highlight the importance of the Word of God in our lives, Pope Francis, in his apostolic letter ("Aperuit illis"), designated the third Sunday in Ordinary Time as a specific Sunday on which to celebrate the Word of God and enable all of us to apply it more directly to our lives. The title of the apostolic letter "Aperuit illis", is derived from its opening words, which are taken from St Luke's Gospel. Here the Evangelist describes how the Risen Jesus appeared to His disciples at Emmaus, and how "He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures". Pope Francis adds that this demonstrates the unbreakable bond between Sacred Scripture and the Eucharist. "It is the Holy Spirit who makes Sacred Scripture the living word of God, experienced and handed down in the faith of His holy people". We are encouraged to let ourselves be nourished by the Word of God, in order to acknowledge and live fully our relationship with God and with our brothers and sisters".(vaticannews.va/moto-proprio-Sunday-word-of-god, 14/12/2019). The Second Vatican Council issued a Constitutional document in 1965 (Dei Verbum, Word of God) which urged all the faithful to prayerfully learn to know Jesus through the scriptures and in doing so to dialogue with God (Dei Verbum note 25).
