**GOSPEL REFLECTION LUKE 24:13-35**

At times in our lives, we have been “the disciples on the road to Emmaus;” feeling lost, alone, sad, confused, and perhaps angered by our personal Calvary experience. True, it was not literally our crucifixion and death. Yet, most likely it was a time of great pain, confusion, anger, sadness or loss. Or it might have been a time when a significant person or part of your life died to you. Take a moment and remember one of your Calvary experiences. Like the disciples who never thought they would lose Jesus, you also were lost, sad, confused, depressed and perhaps angry. What was that time in life like for you? How long did it take you to begin to recover and begin to come back to life? Did your faith sustain you during this time or did God feel light years away from you? Was there any sense, small though it may have been, that God, Jesus, or the Spirit was with you, sustaining you, strengthening you? These times are extremely difficult and they may threaten our trust and faith in God. We all know that bad things happen to good people; however, when they happen to us, our natural reaction is to question: “Why me? Why did God let this happen?” If we hold onto our faith in God, Jesus eventually will appear to us again, most likely in unexpected ways, places, or people. Will our mind and hearts be open or will they be closed by anger, fear, and loss? Today may we pray for the grace to trust that Jesus will come to us. Pope Francis has declared that the 3. Sunday of Ordinary Time will now be known as “Sunday of the Word of God”. “May the Sunday of the Word of God help his people to grow in religious and intimate familiarity with the sacred Scriptures.” The Bible is not meant for a privileged few, continues Pope Francis. It belongs “to those called to hear its message and to recognize themselves in its words”. The Bible cannot be monopolized or restricted to select groups either, he writes, because it is “the book of the Lord’s people, who, in listening to it, move from dispersion and division towards unity”. The Pope concludes his Apostolic Letter by defining what he describes as “**the great challenge before us in life: to listen to Sacred Scripture and then to practice mercy**”. God’s Word, writes Pope Francis, “has the power to open our eyes and to enable us to renounce a stifling and barren individualism and instead to embark on a new path of sharing and solidarity”.

**LITURGICAL CELEBRATION THIS WEEK**

**January 28—St. Thomas Aquinas** followed Christ in poverty and service. He was canonized in 1323 and declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope St. Pius V.

**January 30—Blessed Bronislaw Markiewicz, founder of Congregation of St Michael the Archangel.** He was born on July 13, 1842, in Eastern Poland. He had a particular sensitivity towards the moral, religious, and material negligence of the youth, as well as the misery the poor. *Blessed Bronislaw, pray for us as that our youth may be formed academically, spiritually and physically and seek to serve God with their particularly giftedness in the Church, through Christ our LORD. Amen.*

**January 31—St John Bosco** St. John Bosco was the founder of the Salesian Society, named in honor of St. Francis de Sales, and of the Daughters of Mary, Help of Christians. His lifework was the welfare of young boys and girls, hence his title, "Apostle of Youth."

**THE FIVE FIRST SATURDAYS DEVOTION**

Our Lady of Fatima Promises all the Graces Necessary for Heaven if a Catholic Finishes the Five First Saturdays Devotion. “Whether the world has war or peace depends on the practice of this devotion, along with the consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Our Lady then spoke: *“Tell them that I promise to assist at the hour of death with the graces necessary for salvation all those who, in order to make reparation to me, on the First Saturday of five successive months, go to confession, receive Holy Communion, say five decades of the Rosary, and keep me company for a quarter of an hour, meditating on the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary.”*


